Underground Railroad

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD TOUR Various Jacksonville Locations

Jacksonville has nine documented Underground Railroad sites which were important to this historic endeavor during the



years before the Civil War. Although most are private residences, many of the homes used during this time can still be seen in Jacksonville. For more information, visit **jacksonvilleil.org** to download a map and brochure.

WOODLAWN FARM

1463 Gierke Road, east of Jacksonville

This farm is the showcase homestead of Jacksonville's extensive Underground Railroad network. Former slaves were ushered through this home on their way to freedom. Open Memorial Day to Labor Day, Saturday & Sunday 1 to 4 pm or by appointment. Suggested donation: \$5.





Other Historic Sites

BANDSTAND

Community Park, Main Street & Morton Avenue

The bandstands in Community Park were originally built as part of the grounds of the State Hospital.

ELI BRIDGE FERRIS WHEEL

Community Park, Main Street & Morton Avenue Although the factory is not open for tours, visitors can take a spin on the locally-operated wheel in Community Park during the summer and autumn months. Jacksonville is home to the Eli Bridge factory that builds rides including the famous Big Eli Wheel, Scramblers, and other attractions.



GOVERNOR JOSEPH DUNCAN MANSION Duncan Park

Not all official Illinois Governors' Mansions were located in Springfield! Built in 1834, the mansion was used for State business during the term of Gov. Joseph Duncan from 1834-1838.

It was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1971 and houses many of the original Duncan

family furnishings. Open Memorial Day to Labor Day, Wednesday & Saturday 1 to 4 pm. Suggested donation: Adults, \$5 and Children, \$3.

ILLINOIS SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF & ALUMNI ASSOCIATION MUSEUM

125 Webster Ave, Main Building

The museum has 13 rooms of displays. Open Monday to Friday 10 am to 3 pm. Adults, ASL & college students: \$3, students and children under 5 are free.





JACKSONVILLE AREA MUSEUM

301 East State Street

Jacksonville's newest museum features the stories and artifacts of the Jacksonville area's history, people, and events. The museum is housed in the old Jacksonville Post Office, which has been renovated to become one of the area's leading interpreters of history. Check hours at **jacksonvilleareamuseum.org**

This facility is set within 7 acres of dog-friendly fun! The park is on the shores of Mauvaisterre Lake, across from the east entrance to Nichols Park.

CENTRAL PARK

Located in the center of the historic downtown

A beautiful Civil War monument highlights this area of constant activity in the heart of Jacksonville.

DUNCAN PARK

1200 block of West State Street

The Duncan Mansion, home of former Illinois Governor Joseph Duncan, stands in the park.

JACKSONVILLE COMMUNITY PARK

Corner of Main Street & Morton Avenue

This 60 acre park is equipped with new, all access playground equipment, picnic areas, soccer fields, and a historic Eli Bridge Ferris Wheel. It also includes a 5,000 sq. ft. skate park that features 10 pieces of equipment including grind boxes, rails, and more.





NICHOLS PARK

West Vandalia Street

The largest of the parks, Nichols Park covers 86 acres in southeast Jacksonville and offers an Olympic-size swimming pool. A large, well-equipped playground lies on the south side of the park. Along with the 18hole Links, an additional 9-hole golf course winds through the park. There are gazebos and covered picnic facilities big enough for any family reunion.

East Vandalia Road, east of Nichols Park

The property includes a 1/4 mile long nature trail with other side trails along Lake Mauvaisterre. The trail is suitable for hiking, biking, jogging, or viewing local wildlife and plant life. The nature trail includes tree identification signs.

BIG ELI FERRIS WHEEL

Community Park, Morton Avenue & Main Street Why does Jacksonville love ferris wheels? In 1893, W.E. Sullivan visited the Colombian Exposition where he marveled at the original Ferris Wheel. Sullivan's first "Big Eli" Wheel debuted in Jacksonville, Illinois' own Central Park on May 23, 1900. The first wheel, Big Eli Wheel #1, now proudly stands in front of the factory here in Jacksonville where they still make Big Eli wheels today. Although the factory is not open for tours, visitors can take a spin on the locally-operated wheel in Community Park during the summer and autumn months. Sunday: 4 to 6 pm, Memorial Day through autumn (weather permitting) and on holidays.

It's easy to get to Jacksonville by highway or air. Interstate 72 and Routes 67, 267, 104, and 78 all converge in the city. Convenient commercial air service is available through Springfield, Bloomington, or St. Louis. Jacksonville Municipal Airport is available for private aircraft. Amtrak serves the nearby communities of Springfield or Quincy.

From Springfield

Take Interstate 72 west, 25 minutes to Jacksonville.

From St. Louis

Take Route 367 north to Route 267 north for a 2 hour journey to Jacksonville. If interstate routes are preferred, a simple alternative is 55 north to Springfield, then 72 west to Jacksonville.
